Medical Emergency Distribution System and Points-of-Dispensing: Virtual Basic Training Course

This 1.5 course will provide participants with an overview of the Rhode Island Medical Emergency Distribution System (MEDS) and the centralized points-of-dispensing (PODs) that would be established in the event of a public health emergency. PODs provide medications or vaccinations to the public to prevent illness or death. Participants will learn the purpose and functions of a POD and issues related to mass medical countermeasure (alternatively: mass medication or vaccination) dispensing. This course has been modified to virtual format to ensure adherence to social distancing guidelines during the COVID-19 pandemic.





Intended Audience:

Municipal staff who would staff a POD in an emergency, community members who wish to become POD volunteers, CERT members, and municipal leaders.

Course Objective:

Train <u>potential</u> POD staff to a standard level to be capable of working in a POD through learning about:

- The Strategic National Stockpile (SNS)
- The Rhode Island Medical Emergency Distribution System (MEDS)
- Elements of POD set-up and operation
