

**What else might I qualify
for in TCCAA's
Energy Department?**

- **Appliance Management Program** will examine electrical use in the home (computerized audit) and replace light bulbs and refrigerators when needed.
- **Weatherization Assistance Program** assists income eligible individuals and families to permanently reduce their energy consumption and increase energy efficiency. Energy audits conducted will determine the need for insulation, weather stripping and pipe sealer.
- **Boiler Repair/Replacement** provides boiler repair services and replacement for heating systems that are beyond repair.
- **Good Neighbor Fund** grant provides assistance for people who are experiencing a financial crisis in regards to heat or electric source. (may be eligible for both heap and gnf assistance)

What is Heating Assistance?

The program provides grants to reduce home heating costs for oil, natural gas, electric, propane, wood, kerosene and coal to income eligible families even if your heat is included in rent.

What do I need to bring?

- Income documentation for previous 4 weeks.
- Current electric bill
- Current heating bill
- Social Security Cards for all household members
- Birth Certificates for all household members
- Photo ID for applicant
- If rental, copy of lease or rental agreement
- If homeowner, proof of ownership
- Proof of residence i.e., current utility bill

Quick Stats:

Tri-County Community Action Agency Weatherization Program

- ◆ Tri-County Community Action Agency provided Weatherization services to nearly 300 homes in our service area
- ◆ Families received an average of nearly \$4,000 in materials and labor for installation of weatherization measures.
- ◆ That means TCCAA saved local families nearly \$1 million in installation costs, and thousands of dollars on their energy bills.

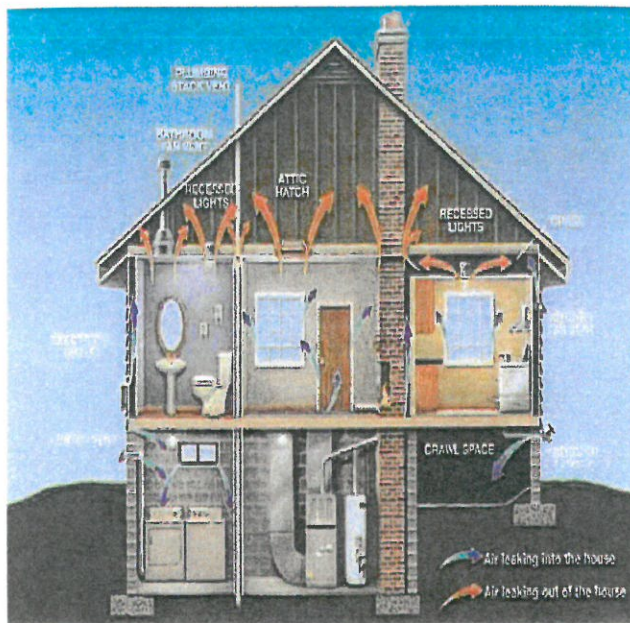
That's exactly what the Tri-County Community Action Weatherization Program is here to do.
