TOWN OF HOPKINTON WATERLINE HOOKUP PROCEDURES FOR NEW APPLICANTS

- 1. Kindly complete following steps to apply for a waterline service connection to the Town's water distribution system:
 - Applicants shall contact a septic company to have their septic tank pumped and inspected by an ISDS licensed inspector. The inspector will complete a *Septic System Inspection Report* that must be forwarded to the Town Clerk's Office (Wastewater Management Ordinance Chapter 121, Section 14).  - Applicants shall complete the Town of Hopkinton's *Application for a New Waterline Service Connection*. This application is available at the Town Clerk's Office.
 - Applicants shall include a check for \$100.00 made payable to the Town of Hopkinton.
 - Applicants shall mail or return the *Application for a New Waterline Service*, a \$100.00 check payable to the Town of Hopkinton, and a copy of the *Septic System Inspection Report* to the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, 1 Town House Road, Hopkinton, Rhode Island, 02833.
- 2. Applicants will then be contacted by the Town's Water Manager to discuss the following tasks:
 - Contacting a qualified contractor to obtain a cost estimate for the connection from the premises to the curb stop and have the work performed.
 - Contacting a licensed plumber to connect the system to the curb stop. The plumber will then contact the Town's Water Manager to inspect the work before the trench is backfilled.
- 3. Applicants will be contacted by the Town's Water Manager with the results of the final inspection.
